Welcome guide to Baix Llobregat

Baix Llobregat is a county located in the south of the province of Barcelona. It is bordered to the north by Bages, to the east by Vallès Occidental, to the southeast by Barcelonès, to the south by the Mediterranean Sea, to the southwest by Garraf, to the west by Alt Penedès and to the northwest by Anoia.

It has 809,883 inhabitants*, and an area of 486.7 km². The county capital is Sant Feliu del Llobregat.

It is made up of 30 municipalities, five of which surpass 50,000 inhabitants.

Sea, river and mountain define its lands. To its more than 15 km of long stretches of beaches, we can add the sierras of Garraf, Ordal, Collserola and the majestic soaring mountain of Montserrat, great for hiking and outdoor activities surrounded by nature. Finally, the final stretch of the river that is the source of the delta of Llobregat, with an incalculable ecological value and wealth.

Country of reception

Starting in 2000, the social reality of Baix Llobregat started undergoing changes with regard to the migratory phenomenon, with the migratory index increasing significantly in a few short years.

While municipalities like Castelldefels have a foreign population index of 18.6%, for others this number is much lower, like Sant Climent de Llobregat at 1,6%. In parallel, this territorial dispersion goes hand in hand with the diversification of origins of new arrivals.

Thus, in recent years Baix Llobregat has increased its cultural diversity, by welcoming new residents from around the world in recent years**.

This Guide details the main resources and basic welcome services for new arrivals to the county and municipality, which should be a great assistance for understanding how everything works and providing other practical and quality information. It contains useful services and resources and is translated into different languages.

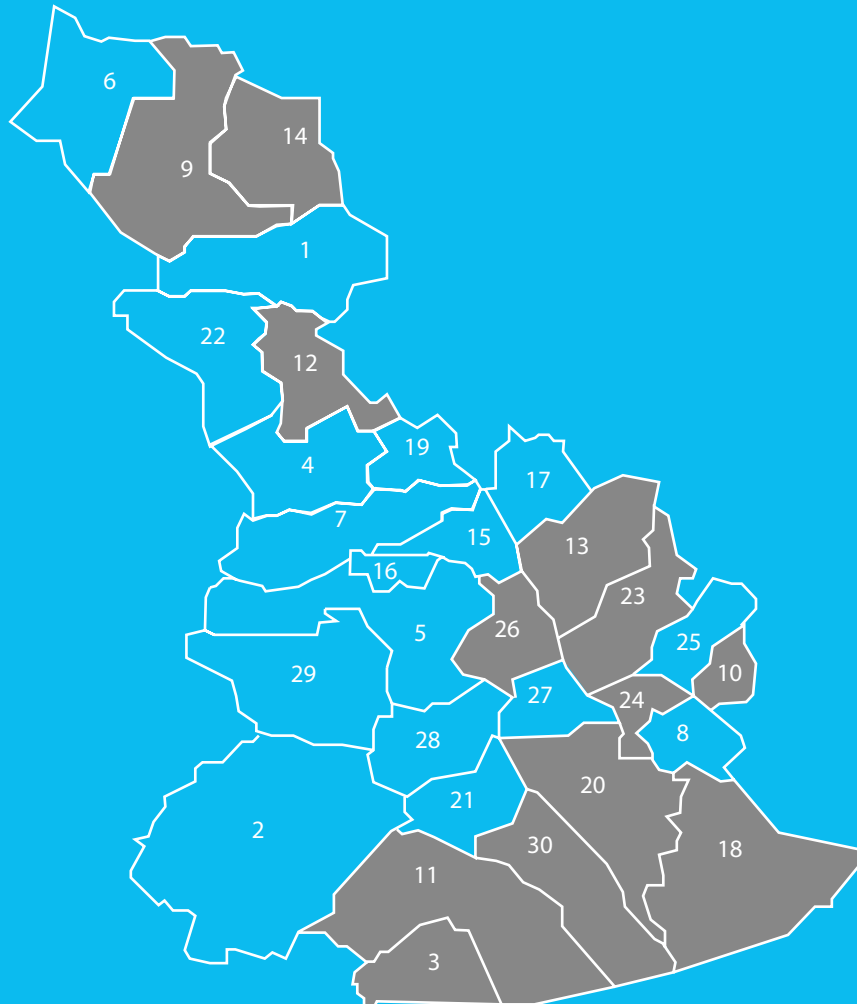

Regional map

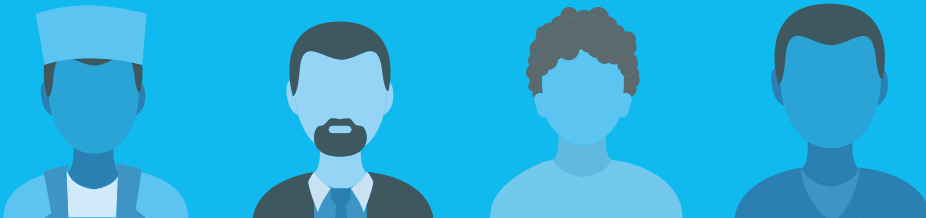

REGISTER




The municipal census is the administrative registry for all residents of the municipality. Registering is free and certifies residency in the city or town where you live*. All people, with and without residence permits, must register. HEALTHCARE



Obtaining your Health Card (Targeta Sanitària):

The Health Card (TSI) will let you access services in the public health system.

All registered people, whether or not they have residence permits, can obtain one. This card lets you access free medical services and care at primary care centres and hospitals in the public health network. You must present it at chemist's to purchase prescription drugs.

Each member of the family must have their own TSI. If you do not have a TSI, you can only receive care if you are under 18 years of age, for emergencies and serious diseases, or if you are a pregnant woman.

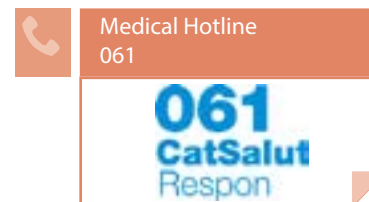

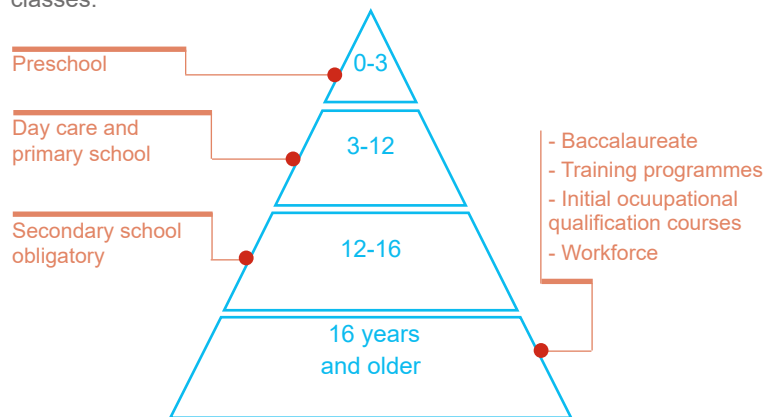
EDUCATION

SOCIAL SERVICES



Social services are for all people who are registered in the municipality, especially those who require special services and assistance, due to being in situations of vulnerability.

They provide access to specialised resources and services to foster people's wellbeing and equal opportunities to all citizens. They attend to the social needs of individuals, families and groups.

Remember that access to specific resources and services (minimum guaranteed income, pensions, etc.) are dependent on the regular or irregular situation of applicants. City councils may establish their own municipal regulations on social services (food banks, etc.).

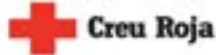

LEGAL GUIDANCE SERVICES



The Legal Guidance Service (Servei d'Orientació Jurídica, SOJ) is a public and free service that provides personal assistance. It is funded by the Department of Justice, through the Secretariat of Relations with the Justice Administration. This service also advises citizens on their rights to attain free legal assistance, and the documentation required to apply for it. The advisory services it provides are general and, therefore, questions that can be asked include all legal matters regulated by social relations: separations, divorces, family mediation, rental of housing, purchase contracts, traffic accidents, insurance policies, etc.
